The Annapurna bird watching tour is within the Annapurna conservation area special birds there are includes Golden Eagle, Himalayan Monal, Kalij Pheasant, Spiny Babbler, Red-billed Blue Magpie; Small Racquet-tailed Drongo, Green-shrike Babbler, Green-tailed Sunbird, Booted and Bonelli's Eagle, Ibisbill, Slaty-backed Forktails, Himalayan Griffon, Lammergeyer, and Crested Serpent Eagle etc.

Trip Itinerary

Day 1 : Arrival Kathmandu, Rest & briefing

Day 2 : Full Day Bird walk Phulchoki with pack lunch

In Phulchoki Jungle, you will have the opportunity to witness a diverse range of bird species in their natural habitat. The lush surroundings and tranquil atmosphere make it an ideal location for bird-watching enthusiasts. After a fulfilling day of birding, you can unwind and relax at a comfortable hotel in Kathmandu, ensuring a restful night's sleep before your next adventure.

Day 3 : Half Day Bird walk Bagmati River + Half Day Local Sightseeing

Day 4 : Drive from Kathmandu to Pokhara

Upon reaching Pokhara, you will be received and driven to the hotel. Check into the hotel in Pokhara.

Day 5 : Drive to Nayapull and go Birding and Trekking to Ghandruk 1960m

Drive to Nayapul and go birding in Ghandruk. Nayapul is a small town located near Pokhara that serves as the starting point for various treks in the Annapurna region. Once you arrive in Nayapul, you can embark on a scenic trek towards Ghandruk while also indulging in birdwatching along the way. The trail offers breathtaking views of the Himalayas and diverse bird species, making it a perfect adventure for nature enthusiasts and trekkers alike.

Day 6 : Birding and Trekking from Ghandrung to Tadapani 2500m .

Birding and trekking from Ghandrung to Tadapani are popular activities among nature enthusiasts in Nepal. Ghandrung, located in the Annapurna region, offers breathtaking views of the Himalayas and is home to a variety of bird species. Birders may observe a vast diversity of avian life in this location, including the colorful Kalij pheasants and many other species.

When birding and trekking from Ghasa to Marpha, you will see fewer birds. compared to other popular birding destinations. This is because the Ghasa to Marpha route is known more for its stunning mountain views and challenging trekking trails, rather than being a prime birdwatching spot. Day 11 : Birding and Trekking from Marpha to Muktinath

Comparatively to Marpha and Muktinath, birding and trekking are quite interesting because they offer a special fusion of nature and spirituality. The birding experience allows you to witness a variety of mountain species in their natural habitat, while trekking through the picturesque landscapes provides breathtaking views of the surrounding mountains and valleys. Additionally, reaching Muktinath offers a chance to explore the sacred temple and immerse yourself in the rich cultural heritage of the region.

Day 12 : Birding and Trekking from Muktinath to Jomosom

Birding from Muktinath to Jomosom offers a thrilling experience with a diverse range of habitats, including alpine meadows and river valleys, attracting a variety of bird species, including rare and beautiful ones like the Chukar Partridge and Snow Partridge.

Day 13 : Fly or Drive from Jomosom to Pokhara

When traveling from Jomosom to Pokhara, you have the option to either fly or drive. Flying is a quicker and more convenient mode of transportation, taking approximately 20 minutes. On the other hand, driving allows you to enjoy the scenic beauty of the region and takes around 7-8 hours, depending on road conditions.

Day 14 : Drive to Chitwan Sauraha

The drive from Pokhara to Chitwan Sauraha takes approximately 4-5 hours, depending on traffic and road conditions. Along the way, you'll pass through scenic landscapes, including lush green hills and small villages. It's advisable to start early in the morning to make the most of your day in Chitwan Sauraha and to avoid heavy traffic on the route.

Day 15 : Full Day Birding Royal National Park Chitwan

Day 19 : Birding in Koshi Tappu Wildlife Reserve
