This allows you to explore various habitats and elevations, increasing your chances of spotting different bird species. Nature Trail Trekking, offer round the year birding trip however for the best time for a Langtang Helambu birding tour is during the spring (March to May) and autumn (September to November) seasons when the weather is pleasant, and bird activity is high.

Trip Itinerary

Day 1 : Arrival Kathmandu, Rest & briefing

Upon arrival, you will be welcomed by one of the representative of Nature Trail Travel & Tours. He will then further escort you to your respective hotel for overnight stay.

Day 2 : Drive to Shybrubenshi from Kathmandu

The drive from Kathmandu to Shybrubenshi is approximately 120 kilometers and takes around 6 hours, depending on traffic and road conditions. The route offers stunning views of the Himalayas and passes through picturesque villages, making it a scenic journey worth experiencing.

Day 3 : Trekking and Birding to Thulo Shyabru village

From Shyabrubenshi trekking and Birding to Thulo Shyabru village, the journey takes you through lush forests and picturesque landscapes. Along the way, you will have the opportunity to spot various species of birds, making it a paradise for birdwatchers.

Day 4 : Trekking and Birding to Chopche

Thulo Shyabru is a popular destination for both trekking and birding enthusiasts. The breathtaking landscapes and diverse bird species make it an ideal spot for combining these two activities. From Thulo Shyabru, trekkers can embark on thrilling trails that lead to the picturesque village of Chopche, offering a unique opportunity to explore the stunning natural beauty while spotting various bird species along the way.

Day 5 : Trekking and Birding to Lauribina

After the Chopche, you can immerse yourself in the breathtaking landscapes while engaging in activities such as trekking and birding. As one continues their journey towards Lauribina, they will be captivated by the stunning mountain views of the Langtang range and Ganesh Himal and have the opportunity to explore the diverse avian species that inhabit this region.

Day 6 : Rest Day and birding around

Take advantage of this rest day to acclimate to the high altitude, letting your body adjust and lowering your chance of altitude sickness. Make the most of your time by going on a full-day birding expedition near Lauribina, where you will be immersed in the varied kinds of birds that inhabit this gorgeous location. You can stroll down to Cholangpati for birding today and then back to Lauribina in the evening.

Day 7 : Trekking and Birding to Gosaikunda Lake

Passing through the beautiful Langtang National Park and trekking and birding to Gosaikunda Lake from Lauribina offers a mesmerizing experience for nature enthusiasts. The trail takes you through alpine meadows and scenic landscapes, providing ample opportunities to spot a variety of highland bird species along the way. As you reach Gosaikunda Lake, situated at an altitude of 4,380 meters, you are rewarded with breathtaking views of the surrounding snow-capped peaks.

Day 8 : Trekking and Birding to Ghopte

On the route from Gosaikunda Lake to Ghopte, the Lauribina Pass (4610 m) provides stunning views of Himalayan peaks and a variety of bird species. You will be rewarded with stunning vistas of alpine meadows and glacier lakes after a challenging ascent over the Laurebina Pass. After taking a memorable photo on the top of the pass, descend to Ghopte. The descent from the Lauribina Pass to Ghopte offers a thrilling adventure as you navigate through rocky terrain and dense forests. Along the way, keep an eye out for elusive wildlife such as musk deer and Himalayan monals, adding to the excitement of your trek.

Day 9 : Treking and Birding to Tharepati

Birding from Ghopte to Tharepati is a popular activity among nature enthusiasts. This scenic trek offers the opportunity to spot a wide variety of bird species, like the Great Parrotbill and many others, in their natural habitat. The lush forests and alpine meadows along the trail provide the perfect environment for birdwatching, making it a memorable experience for avid birders.

Day 10 : Rest Day and birding around Tharepati

After a challenging trek, taking a rest day at Tharepati is well-deserved. Besides rejuvenating your body and mind, Tharepati also offers a fantastic opportunity for birdwatching.
